GUIDELINES FOR PAPER PRESENTATION

- The Oral Paper presentation will be in MS Power point with time limit of six minutes followed by 2 minutes for discussion.

- The first slide must include the title of the paper, name and designation of the presenter, conference registration number and IAFM Life Member Number (If available)
- For header; the font size must be more than 13 and the rest of the content must not exceed the font size of 11.
- In cases of images, the identity of an individual must not get disclosed.
- To participate in award session delegate must be IAFM Life / Provisional Member. The interested participant for the Award Session must clearly mention their IAFM life / Provisional membership number in presentation. IAFM Award committee will scrutinize the papers and the score given by the judges. Final participants for award session will be chosen and informed by IAFM award committee. Any non IAFM member can participate in the award session by becoming a provisional member by submitting application form which is available on the website <http://www.iafmonline.in/data/application-form.pdf>. before 16th January 2024. Guidelines For E-Poster Presentation

- Only the registered delegates are entitled to present their posters following their acceptance by the committee.
- Time limit: 03 mins (presentation) + 01 min (discussion).
- The author should be available for the presentation of the E-poster.
- All posters should be designed in landscape style and all information i.e. text, data, photos, and figures should appear within one slide/image as a PPT or JPEG image.
- If the candidate wishes to explain the poster in detail, a maximum of 5 slides shall be allowed strictly adhering to the timeline.
- The title of the E-poster should be brief and match the topic.
- The title and subheadings should be written in bold. Select background colors that contrast well with the font to allow easy text reading.
- Photographs or figures being used in the poster should be of minimum 300 dpi resolution.
